Location Wizard

Discussion: The Location Wizard is designed to help track movements of an animal or group. You can setup different lots, pens, paddocks, etc. and associate a Premises ID with each of those locations. The Location Wizard allows you to report on an individual animal record or on the Location.

To start, the Location Wizard can be accessed through Utilities > Location Wizard or from the button bar in Cow Sense ()

The Location Wizard has complete step by step instructions in the help documentation. Just click on the question mark button (see picture below).



The Location Wizard is dedicated to handling location assignments for your cattle by ranch, by pasture, or however it is important to track animal locations in your operation. You will set up your own locations as the first step in using the wizard.

Premises IDs are included in the Location Wizard to provide the ability to record National Animal Identification Premises Numbers if you wish to do so. Include your Premises ID with a location, and Cow Sense will be able to include this information on reports.

The Location Wizard maintains its own database of cattle movements, which enables you to track an animal through space and time. Also, whenever an animal is assigned to a location, these fields are updated on the animal's record in the Cow Sense database: Location, Location Date, and Premises ID. You can select and report on these fields in a custom reports. Only the last location information is stored in Cow Sense, all historical movement information is available from the Location Wizard Menu.
